

## **DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE**

### **1. TEACHING & LEARNING PROCESS :**

The department has a well-equipped ICT enabled class room with internet facility. The classes are interactive and student centered. The students and teachers are also connected through whatsapp for various informations regarding doubts in studies, exam, schedules, etc.

### **2. LAB FACILITY :**

The department has a computer with internet facility. The degree students are benefited from the computer lab. They do projects & practical classes in the computer lab.

### **3. SEMINAR LIBRARY :**

The department has a rich seminar library with more than 600 books. Out of which 200 books are course books based on the new CBCS course. Each year new books are purchased from the seminar fund. Books are issued to honors students by Prof I/C of Seminar library. Dates of issue and return are maintained properly. Seminar books are not given to students with nil attendance.

### **4. PROCTORIAL CLASSES :**

Proctorial classes are conducted at regular interval for the honors students of all the three years by their respective proctors. Monthly test marks, percentage of attendance and personal problem (if any) are discussed in proctorial classes. The students having poor attendance & poor performance in class test, mid semester and in semester exams are given special importance and concern. A register is maintained for this purpose.

### **5. MONTHLY TEST :**

In each semester, monthly test is conducted and the valued answer sheets are given to the students. So that they can improve their performance for next exam. Results are mentioned/recorded in a separate register for test and exams.

### **6. ANY ACHIEVEMENTS FOR STAFF & STUDENTS :**

The department occupies a vital position in the college in terms of student's achievement. In the academic session 2018-2019, one student has been awarded the best graduate and felicitated by Honorable Minister Ranendra Pratap Swain.

## 7. SEMINARS:

Department organizes seminars. Student's seminar is conducted by the second year and the third year students on the topic related to commerce. Whenever possible resource persons are invited to deliver seminars. During the academic session 2019-20, Prof. Bhagban das, Professor & Head, Department of Business Management, Fakir Mohan University had come to deliver seminar on the topic "Recession & its implication in Indian economy."
