
# GOPABANDHU SCIENCE COLLEGE ATHGARH, CUTTACK FEEDBACK REPORT ANALYSIS 2017-18


The institute emphasizes students' holistic development and progression to meet the desired outcomes. The institute strives to maintain highest standard in the teaching learning process and takes a gazillion of initiatives for enhancement of quality education for the interest of students and assesses the outcomes of the teaching learning process and of the initiatives taken by collecting feedback from the stakeholders, primarily from the students. The institute feels that Student feedback is a vital lifeblood for a thriving curriculum. It offers unique insights into how students are actually experiencing the learning process. By analysing their perspectives on content relevance, difficulty level, teaching methods, and resources, institutions can identify areas for improvement and ensure the curriculum stays aligned with student needs. This not only leads to improved learning outcomes and increased student satisfaction, but also fosters a culture of engagement where students feel their voices are heard and valued. Hence, the institute has developed a string mechanism for feedback collection, analysis and corrective measures.



In this line, at the end of the 2017-18 academic session, upon the recommendation of IQAC and as a matter of practise, feedback on different aspects were collected from the students. A total of 270 no. of students participated in this process and provided their valued feedback. The feedbacks were then handed over to the Academic Bursar, who, along with the

Director IQAC, examined the feedback report, analyzed them and prepared a comprehensive report along with his suggestive views and presented in in the last academic council for further action. The Detailed report is appended herewith.






At the end of the academic session, feedback was collected from a total of 270 students from all streams of 1<sup>st</sup> year,2<sup>nd</sup> Year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year. The names of the students have been kept anonymous. The details of the students taken part in the feedback collection process is given below.

The students were given a total of 15 questions on the overall facilities of the institute ranging from syllabus coverage to physical facilities available at the college. While preparing the questions, all aspects of the institution (scholastic and co-scholastic) have been taken into consideration so as to generate an in-depth understanding of the students' perception of the college, which shall ultimately help the institution taking quality enhancement measures. After collection of feedback, the forms were thoroughly analyzed and it was found out that while the college has performed well in some areas, there are certain grey areas where necessary steps need to be taken by the administration and the teachers.


A proper analysis of the report along with the decisions taken in the meeting held in presence of the Academic council and the IQAC is given hereunder.

# 1. The Syllabus has been covered in the class




While 172 students (63.7%) of the students strongly agree that the syllabus has been covered in the class, 64 students(23.7%) agree with the statement and 18 students(8.66%) students have preferred to remain neutral. Only 11 students(4.07%) students disagree with the statement and 5 strongly disagreed with it.

### The teacher has delivered the content of the syllabus in the most effective manner.




While 158 students(58.51%) students strongly agree that teacher has delivered the content of the syllabus in the most effective manner, 64 students(23.7%) agree with the statement and 22 (8.14%) have remained neutral. 13 students (4.81%) have opined that the content was not delivered in the most effective manner and the same number of students strongly support this.

3. The teachers have been interactive and have addressed the needs of the students




While 155 (57.4%) of the students have strongly agreed with the statement, 65 (24.07%) students agree with it and 31(11.48%) students have remained neutral. On the other hand, 8 (2.96%) students have strongly disagreed and 11 (4.07%) students have disagreed with the statement.

4. The teachers have used ICT and have provided you learning resources and e-resources for enhancement of understanding




142 students(52.59%) students have opined that they strongly agree with the statement and 68(25.18%) students have opined that they agree with the statement. While36 students (13.33%) students have preferred to remain neutral, 13 (4.81%) students have preferred to disagree and 11 (4.07%) students have preferred to strongly disagree with the statement.

5. What is your opinion on the remedial programme of your respective department?




While 175 students(64.81%) students have rated the remedial programme excellent, 63 (23.33%) students have said that it is good and 17 (6.29%) students have preferred to opt average. Conversely, Only 7 students (2.59%) think that it is poor and 8 students(2.96%) have rated it very poor.

6. Rate the overall teaching quality of the teacher




While 162 students(60%) students have rated the teaching quality of the teachers excellent, 59 (21.85%) students have said that it is good and 28 (10.37%) students have preferred that it is average. Conversely, 11 students (4.07%) think that it is poor and 10 students (3.7%) have rated it very poor.

7. Rate the overall teaching learning process of the institute




While 180 students(66.66%) students have rated the teaching quality of the teachers excellent, 43 (15.92%) students have said that it is good and 20 (7.4%) students have rated it average. On the otherhand, 15 students (5.55%) think that it is poor and 12 students (4.44%) have rated it very poor.

8. The office staff of the college are cooperative and ready to assist you on every matter in time of need.





9. The college addressed the needs and redressed the grievances of the students in time





10. The examination and evaluation system adopted by the college is effective and enhances the learning outcomes






12. Rate the library facilities (Books, reference books, other supporting material ) of the college





# 13. Rate the overall infrastructural and lab facilities of the college.




While 167 students (61.85%) have rated the facilities excellent, 58 students(21.48%) have rated it good and 21(7.77%) have rated average. While 168 students(62.22%) students have rated the cleanliness excellent, 75(27.77%) students have said that it is good and 8 (2.96%) students have rated it Average. On the other hand, 12 students (4.44%) think that it is poor and 2 students (2.59%) have rated it very poor.
